QUALIFICATIONS FOR TENDERING

Mandatory Requirements

- a. certified copy of Certificate of Incorporation
- b. Valid practicing license as a contractor (Roads & Civil Works NCA 6,7, & 8)
- c. Certified copy of VAT & PIN registration certificates
- d. Valid Tax compliance certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)
- e. Copy of CR 12 (valid)
- f. National Identity Cards / Passports of Directors
- g. Valid Single Business Permit
- h. Certified copy of Valid Certificate of Registration for Access to Government Procurement Opportunities (AGPO), from the national treasury (For disadvantage groups, Women, Youth and Persons with Disability).
- i. Those bidding for Persons with Disabilities contracts must attach copies of IDs issued by the NCPWD for the Directors who are disabled (Certified Copies).
- j. Certified copies of Log books for ownership of Machines and Equipment. Those hiring Must provide certified copies of Lease Agreements.
- k. Current Sworn Affidavit not more than 3 months from the tender opening date
- l. Current Bank statement in contractor's name -3 months current bank statement
- m. Authority to seek reference from Contractors bankers
- n. Provide letter from the Bank proving that directors in CR12 are signatories to the account
- o. Form of tender correctly filled, signed & stamped
- p. Confidential Business Questionnaire correctly filled, signed & stamped
- q. Bidders Must Serialize sequentially all pages of the tender documents.
- r. Submit a brief Work Methodology
- s. To enhance equitability, no company shall be allowed to bid for more than (two) road **per** constituency.
- t. Preference shall be given to constituency contractors, that were unsuccessful for the last (2) financials years.
- u. **Recent beneficiaries & companies with current awards shall NOT be eligible at all.**

Other Requirements

As specified in the respective tender documents covering the following:

1. Similar previous experience where applicable (Not applicable to special group category)
2. Professional and Technical Personnel (provide CVs for the employees)
3. Turnover and liquid Assets Supported by Audited Accounts for the previous two (2) years (Not applicable to special group category)
4. Current work load if any

5. Litigation History (Provide sworn Affidavit) – executed within 3 months of the tender opening date.
6. Any form of Canvassing will lead to disqualification
7. Subsequent to presidential directives issued on the COVID-19 pandemic there shall be no pre-tender site visit, bidders are advised to make their own personal arrangements to familiarize themselves with the site before submission of their bids and ensure their site visit certificates are duly signed by respective Officer.
8. **Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, contractors representative shall not be allowed during opening, however, the opening register shall be put on Public Notice**

NOTE:

1. All certification of documents shall be original and executed by Commissioner for Oaths or Notaries Public.
2. Certificates / Licenses may be verified from or with the Issuing Authorities or Agencies
